ROUTE NO. 6.
 From the Kansas line south of Chetopa, via Vinita, Big Cabin, Adair, Pryor, Choctaw, Wagoner, Muskogee, Oktaha, Checotah, Eufaula, Canadian, Crowder, McAlester, Savannah, Kiowa, Stringtown, Atoka, Tushka, Caney, Caddo, Durant, Calera, Colbert, and to the Red River bridge north of Dennison, Texas.

ROUTE NO. 7.
 From the Kansas state line south of Baxter Springs, via Ficher, Cardin, Commerce, Miami, Afton, Vinita, Chelsea, Claremore, Catoosa, Tulsa, Sapulpa, Kelleyville, Bristolow, Dewey, Stroud, Davenport, Chandler, Wellston, Luther, Arcadia, Edmond, Oklahoma City, Blanchard, Chickasha, Ninnekah, Cement, Cyril, Fletcher, Lawton, Cache, Snyder, Headrick, Altus, Duke, Holsa, and the Texas line toward Wellington, Texas.



ROUTE NO. 8.
 From Kansas state line south of Kiowa, via Cherokee, Carmen, Aline, Cleo, Fairview, Okeene, Hixhook, Watonga, Greenfield, Geary, Bridgeport, Binger, Grace-mont, Anadarko, Apache, Lawton, Ranch-let, to Red River bridge north of Burkburnett, Texas.

ROUTE NO. 9.
 Beginning at Spiro in LeFlore county, at a connection with State Highway No. 2, via Keota, Stigler, Porum, Cleotah, Hixhook, Hoffman, Grayson, Koss, Dewar, Henryetta, Okemah, Boley, Padon, Prague, Meeker, Harrah, Oklahoma City, Blanchard, Chickasha, Verden, Anadarko, Fort Cobb, Carnegie, Mountain View, Getula, Hobart, Lone Wolf, Granite, Man-zum, Reed, and west to the Texas state line.

ROUTE NO. 10.
 From Missouri state line south of Joplin, (or from Miami) via Wynawotte, Grove, May, Tahlequah, Fort Gibson, Braggs, Gore, Webbers Falls, Warner, Porum, Whitefield, Stigler, Keota, Pana-ma, Boreau, Wister, Talihina, Almon, Tuskahoma, Clayton, Antlers, Hugo, Grant, and south to the Red River bridge towards Paris, Texas.

ROUTE NO. 11.
 From Arkansas state line west of Siloam Springs, via Kansas, Locust Grove, Choteau, Inola, Tulsa, Sperry, Slaton, Avant, Barnsdall, Peshing, Pawhuska, Burbank, Ponca City, Tonka-wa, Lamont, Pond Creek, Nash, Jet, Cher-okee, Ingersoll, Alva, Freedom, Buffalo, Gate, Fortson, Hooker, and Guymon to Boise City.

ROUTE NO. 12.

ROUTE NO. 13.

ROUTE NO. 14.
 Beginning at Buffalo in Mayes county, via Supply, Tangier, Woodward, Vici, Custer, Seiling, Taloga, Arapaho, Clinton, Bessie, Cordell, Hobart, Gearyville, Mountain Park, Ad-der, Marilton, Frederick, Davidson, and across Red River bridge toward Vernon, Texas.

ROUTE NO. 15.
 Beginning at the Kansas state line south of Kiowa, via Alva, Waynoka, Quinan, Moorland, Woodward, Tangier, Fargo, Catoosa, Shallick, and south to a connection with State Highway No. 13 running west towards Amarillo, Texas.

ROUTE NO. 16.
 Beginning at the Kansas state line south of Coffeyville, via Lenaph, Delaware, Nowata, Oologah, Collinsville, to Tulsa.

ROUTE NO. 17.
 Arkansas state line west of Siloam Springs, Watts, Westville, Stilwell, Bunch, Marble City, and Stillaw connecting with State Highway No. 1.

ROUTE NO. 18.
 Beginning at a point west of Burbank on State Highway No. 11 in Osage county, via Pawnee, Cushing, Afta, Chandler, Meeker, Shawnee, Tecumseh, Asher, Strat-ford, to Sulphur.

ROUTE NO. 19.
 Beginning at Atoka at a connection with State Highway No. 6, via Lehigh, Phillips, Coalgate, Centrahoma, Tupelo, Stonewall, Ada, Center, and Stratford connecting with State Highway No. 18.

ROUTE NO. 20.
 Beginning at Claremore in Rogers county, at a connection with State High-way No. 7, Pryor, Salina, Sperryman, Jay, to the Arkansas state line.

ROUTE NO. 21.
 Beginning at Tahlequah in Le Flora county, at a connection with State Highway No. 10, via Bethel, Broken Bow, Idabel, Har-worth, Bokoma, to the Arkansas state line toward America, Arkansas. (This route is not open between Albin and Bethel.)

ROUTE NO. 22.
 Beginning at Durant in Bryan county, at a connection with State Highways, No. 3 and 6, via Milburn, Tishomingo, Ravia, Mill Creek, Sulphur, and Davis, to a con-nection with State Highway No. 4.

ROUTE NO. 23.
 Beginning north of Wister in LeFlore county, at a connection with State High-way No. 3, via Howe, Heavener, the Arkansas state line towards McAlester, Arkansas.

ROUTE NO. 24.
 Beginning at Fritch in Tillman county, via Tipton, Altus, Blair, Mangum, Willow, Skye, Cheyenne to the Texas line at a point near Durham.

ROUTE NO. 25.
 Beginning at the Missouri state line, via Grove, Vinita, Nowata, Bartlesville, Paw-huska, Wynona, Bixby, Cleveland, Law-nee, Morrison, and to a junction with State Highway No. 1 in Osage county, twelve miles east of Perry.

ROUTE NO. 26.
 Beginning south of Three Springs in Kay county, via Tonkawa, Blackwell, and Bran-dan, to the Kansas state line.

ROUTE NO. 27.
 Beginning at Okmulgee, via Morris, and Boynton, to Muskogee.

ROUTE NO. 28.
 Beginning at Lawton in Comanche county, via Bunch, Anna, Healdton, Wil-son, Lone Grove, and Ardmore, to a con-nection with State Highways No. 4 and 5.
