








WORLD'S FAIR



For its exhibit at the New York World's Fair, Oklahoma has built a monument-not of stone and steel and glass but of people and land and natural resources. Father than competing architecturally with other exhibitors, the state has found a new and unique method of displaying its most valuable assets.

The Oklahoma World's Fair Commission has chosen a natural, outdoor setting for the Oklahoma exhibit, graphically emphasizing the water development and industrial potential, the recreational advantages and the warm, natural qualities of the Oklahoma people.

WESTERN LIFE in Oklahoma can be wrapped up in one word—Rodeo! Every season gives Oklahoma cowboys a chance to practice at this sport,
